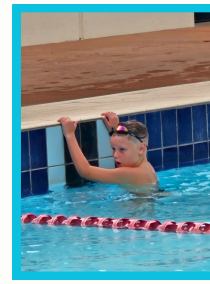
Rural Schools Swimming Sports

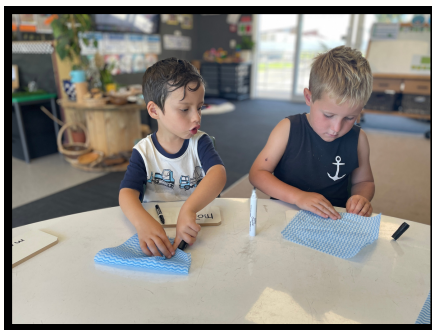
Electives - We need your help ...
